

Beaches

The coast of Ostuni is around 7 km away from the city and is composed by more than 15 km of beautiful beaches. Masseria Bianca is only 2 km away from the nearest beach (Torre Pozzelle).

Main beaches:

Santa Lucia - Torre Pozzella – Wonderful part of the coast, very quiet and natural (no buildings nearby). Many beaches, sandy and rocky, To visit: XVI Century Tower used to control coast by pirates.

Costa Merlata – Sandy and rocky beaches.

Villanova – Other than beaches, there is a small tourist port. To visit: XVI Century Tower-castel on the port side.

Monticelli – High dunes, very quiet and familiar pace – suggested visit to “Quarto di Monte”, a cerenquito where you can drink fresh fruit juices and coquetails in completely relax (or on the beach)

Pilone - Sandy beach close to the typical San Leonardo Tower (XVI Century). Now it is a Regional Natural Reserve (beach advised: Lido Bosco Verde)

Rosa Marina – Many sandy beaches, typical flora macchia mediterranea”, international tourist village, it’s impossible to reach the beaches by car (except if you have a card)

You cannot absolutely miss to go to the **WWF Reserve of Torre Guaceto** (15 km away from the masseria toward Brindisi direction), a fantastic place to visit and with beautiful sea. There you can practice cyclotrekking and seawatching.
